



EARLY VOTING PROCESS

November 4, 2014 General Election



Overview: Any voter registered in Clark County may vote before Election Day at any one of the 89 convenient early voting sites throughout the County from **October 18 (Saturday) to October 31 (Friday)**. Early voting hours and dates of operation vary by location. Locations include shopping malls, super-markets, libraries and community centers. Early voting schedules are in sample ballots, newspapers, and on the [Internet](#).

Voting Machines: All polling places are equipped with [electronic touch-screen voting machines](#). These machines include a voter verifiable paper printout of each ballot. The printout stays with the machine. The machines also provide [Spanish](#), [Filipino](#), and English ballots and instructions.

General Election Voting: Candidates who receive the most votes in a General Election are elected to office. You may vote for all offices and questions on the ballot for your precinct, regardless of your party affiliation.

No Write-Ins: [Nevada Revised Statute \(NRS\) 293.270](#) prohibits write-in candidates.

Early Voting Process:

- Upon arriving at the site, your voting eligibility and signature will be verified before you are allowed to vote. The election Clerk will announce your name, as required by Nevada law ([NRS 293.285](#)).
 - *NOTE: It is always a good idea to bring picture identification with you when you vote.*
- Computers at each site connect to the Election Department's centralized voter files. After the verification process, the Clerk will immediately update your record, thus preventing anyone from voting twice.
- You will then receive an activation card to take to a voting machine.
- Insert the activation card into a voting machine to activate it for your specific precinct. You may then [vote](#).
- When you finish voting, immediately return the activation card to an election official.

Early Voting Turnout: Daily early voting turnout (total voters per site) will be updated on the [Internet](#) each night between approximately 10:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.

Results Tabulation: Tabulated results are not available until after all the polls have closed (after 7:00 p.m.) on Election Day and are on the Clark County Election Department's [Internet](#) site or [TV channel 4](#).
