



EARLY VOTING PROCESS

June 2, 2015 Municipal General Election

BOULDER CITY ONLY



Overview: Boulder City will conduct early voting **from May 20 (Wednesday) to May 23 (Saturday)**. Only voters registered within the specific boundaries of Boulder City may vote before Election Day and only at the City Hall in Boulder City. [Early voting schedules](#) are in sample ballots, newspapers and on the [Internet](#). Login to "[Registered Voter Services](#)" on the Clark County Election Department's home page to find out if you are registered in Boulder City and therefore eligible to vote in the June 2, 2015 Municipal General Election.

Voting Machines: The polling place is equipped with [electronic touch-screen voting machines](#). These machines include a voter verifiable paper printout of each ballot. The printout stays with the machine. The machines provide [Spanish](#), [Filipino \(Tagalog\)](#), and English ballots and instructions.

Municipal General Election Voting: Candidates who receive the most votes in a General Election are elected to office. You may vote for all offices on the ballot for your precinct, regardless of your party affiliation. Municipal Elections are nonpartisan, meaning candidates' parties will not appear on the ballot. No Write-Ins: [Nevada Revised Statute \(NRS\) 293.270](#) prohibits write-in candidates.

Early Voting Process:

- Upon arriving at the site, your voting eligibility and signature will be verified before you are allowed to vote. The election Clerk will announce your name, as required by Nevada law ([NRS 293.285](#)).
 - *NOTE: It is always a good idea to bring picture identification with you when you vote.*
- Computers at each site connect to the Election Department's centralized voter files. After the verification process, the Clerk will immediately update your record, thus preventing anyone from voting twice.
- You will then receive an activation card to take to a voting machine.
- Insert the activation card into a voting machine to activate it for your specific precinct and [vote](#).
- When you finish voting, immediately return the activation card to an election official.

Early Voting Turnout: Daily early voting turnout (total voters per site) will be updated on the [Internet](#) each night of early voting around 8:00 p.m.

Results Tabulation: Tabulated results are not available until after 7:00 p.m. on Election Day and are on the Clark County Election Department's [Internet](#) site or [TV channel 4](#).
