Reasons that a candidate for **PARTISAN office may not appear on the Primary Election Ballot:**

1. A MAJOR PARTY CANDIDATE THAT HAS NO OPPOSING CANDIDATE FROM SAME PARTY: If only one candidate from a major party runs for a partisan office, the candidate will only appear in the General Election (NRS 293.260(5))
2. MINOR PARTY AND INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES: Minor party and independent (no party) candidates running for partisan offices will only appear in the General Election (NRS 293.260(3) and 293.257)

Reasons that a candidate for **NONPARTISAN office may not appear on the Primary Election Ballot (candidates with no party designation are running for nonpartisan offices):**

1. SUPREME COURT JUSTICE - ONLY ONE CANDIDATE: If only one candidate runs for a Justice of the Supreme Court seat, that candidate and the office will only appear in the General Election (NRS 293.260(5))
2. ONLY TWO CANDIDATES: If only two candidates run for a nonpartisan office, that office and those two candidates will only appear in the General Election (NRS 293.260(6))
3. SPECIAL DISTRICT OFFICES APPEAR IN GENERAL ELECTION ONLY: Special district offices (Moapa Valley Water, Virgin Valley Water, Moapa Valley TV Maintenance or Overton Power) only appear in the General Election (Special Acts Chap. 477, §5(1); Special Acts Chap. 100, §5(2); NRS 318.095(1))
