

E Sample Ballots – Frequently Ask Questions

A. Will everyone automatically receive an electronic sample ballot?

Answer: No. You will need to use the Clark County Election’s website (www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote) and you will need to explicitly “opt-in” through **Registered Voter Services**.

B. What do I need to do to receive an electronic sample ballot?

Answer: You will need to explicitly “opt-in” by going to the Clark County Election’s website (www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote), using the **Registered Voter Services** to access the **Request My Sample Ballot Electronically (Go Green)**. A valid email address is required.

C. How can I verify my email and “opt-in” status to receive an electronic sample ballot?

Answer: Your email address will be associated with your voter profile in the future and you will be able to see your “opt-in” email address and “opt-in” status after you log into **Registered Voter Services** on the Clark County Election’s website (www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote).

D. What is the difference between e-mail sample ballots and the sample ballots that have been viewable online after I log into Registered Voter Services?

Answer: The viewable sample ballot pages are the contests you are eligible to vote for. In addition to the sample ballot pages, the e-mail sample ballot will include a barcode for checking-in at early voting sites and a link to the sample ballot booklet which will contain additional election information.

E. If I delete either my confirmation or sample ballot e-mail, is it possible to get another e-mail sent to me?

Answer: Yes, you will need to go to the Clark County Election’s website (www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote); log-in to **Registered Voter Services**, under **Registration Details** your e-mail address will be displayed along with a Re-Send button.

F. Can I use an electronic device (cell phone or tablet) to view my electronic sample ballot while inside the booth voting?

Answer: Yes, you can use the barcode enclosed in your electronic sample ballot email on your device when you come to the polls to check-in. You may also view your sample ballot.

G. Can I electronically mark my choices on my electronic sample ballot (like a fillable PDF)?

Answer: No, the functionality is not available at this time.

H. How much money does the County save on the paper sample ballot when a voter chooses to get the electronic sample ballot?

Answer: The cost savings will be about \$1.80 per sample ballot for each election.

I. Does the electronic sample ballot contain a bar code like on the paper sample ballots that is scanned at early voting sites to check in voters? If so, can the bar code be scanned from my electronic device (cell phone or tablet)?

Answer: Yes

Note: This bar code will only be used for Early Voting.

J. Does the electronic sample ballot contain all of the material that is in the paper sample ballot?

Answer: Yes

K. If my email address becomes inactive at the time my sample ballot is sent to me, what happens?

Answer: If your email is no longer active at the time of the mass electronic sample ballot distribution, you will be opted out by the election system and you will be sent a paper sample ballot by postal mail.

L. How do I opt-out of receiving electronic sample ballots?

Answer: Return to the Clark County Election’s website (www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote), login into **Registered Voter Services** and “opt-out” using the **Send My Sample Ballot Via Mail (Cancel my Email Opt- In)** option.

M. When are electronic sample ballots sent out?

Answer: Voters who requested an electronic sample ballot before the close of registration will receive their ballot beginning on Monday following the Saturday close of registration. Those requested after the close of registration will receive an electronic sample ballot within 24 hours.

N. Can I get statistics on how many electronic sample ballots are sent out versus mail ballots?

O. How do I download or print my electronic sample ballots once it is sent to me?

Answer: Click on the links in your email. The pdf will display. With the use of your pdf software you will have the option to print or save the ballot.
