Their goal is to deliver the living ambiance and atmosphere of any region, something that the existing 2D map browsing world simply cannot do. By streamlining locations and opportunities and replacing superfluous clicks and page changes with a seamless, singular and living user interface, Hover delivers the ultimate intuitive browsing experience. The living 3D model is optimal because it is not a simulation of the real neighborhood, it *is* the real neighborhood.

Hover is a platform that they are building to leverage all sensor-based data that can be captured from the air and from the ground, including images from mobile phones. Many people are already using mapping systems – they know how to navigate where they are going – but they would like to see the

location. Hover is looking to expand the availability of this technology into the county and local governments as well as some commercial markets.
