MINUTES

1. Call to Order

- a. Conformance with Nevada Open Meeting Law – The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:30 am. We have seven voting members, so we have a quorum.
- b. Introduction of Data Committee members and guests: Attendees introduced themselves.

2. Administrative Action

- a. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- b. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

3. Sub-Committee Reports

a. Mapping Services, Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson IT

The committee met this morning and talked about focusing on services with commonality. Below are items they discussed:

- Dustin has the planned land use for the county, so once he receives all files and data, they are going to come up with a solution to make sure it is maintained regularly. After it is up, they will talk about descriptions and what items are exposed for the different entities.
- The committee will look at schools, parks, and trails which are the common services that most people would use.
- They discussed looking at building footprints and possibly inventory the entities to see what people have – if they are maintaining it regularly and what kind of service the committee can provide.
- They talked about looking into foreclosures and providing a foreclosure map service.
- The committee discussed cataloging the services and making it easier for people to look at. Right now, unless you know how to go directly to what you are looking for, it's difficult.

b. Training, Robert Vega, Clark County IT/GISMO

There is nothing to report on training. We hope to get back to this within the next couple of weeks.

4. Street Centerline Update, Robert Vega, Clark County IT;GISMO

Per Robert Vega, they have been working on migrating the Street Centerline to a geodatabase for the past 2-3 years and are down to one final AML. Starting with the July maintenance, they are no longer going to be maintaining the Street Centerline annotation. Annotation is all coverage-based. By the end of August, the Street Centerline will all be geodatabase-based. No more coverages. If you have issues with that, please let Robert know. If you need the coverage, you can convert the shape file over. Everything will be exactly the same with the possibility of a couple of additional items.

5. Python and ArcGIS Server Integration Presentation, Dustin Nelson, Clark County IT/GISMO

Dustin Nelson has been working with Python the past couple of weeks and discovered some great features. He gave a demonstration of Python and ArcGIS server integration. Python is basically the heart of where ESRI is trying to push a lot of their development that's not necessarily web-based.

Per Robert Vega, we will have a presentation on ArcGIS and Security in August.

6. Comments by the General Public

Craig Hale, Southern Nevada Water Authority – They have encountered an unforeseen delay in imagery, due to the contractor not getting the data to them on time. They have only received 80 of 1430 and were expecting to have about 700-800 by this time. They should still receive most of the imagery by July 1. If they receive the imagery by July 15, they can still meet the August deadline. Craig will send an email out prior to next month's meeting and should be able to provide an update at the next meeting. The first set of imagery looked pretty good. Keep in mind that 99% of this was filmed in late February so even though they have lightened it up, there may still be some long and dark shadows; however, it is really good, sharp imagery.
