MINUTES

MEMBERS PRESENT: Brian Bolduc (CCWRD), Hetal Luhar (SNHD), Anthony Willis (CLV), John Ritsko (RTCSNV/Alternate), Michael Todd (CCRFC/Alternate), Robert Vega (CCIT), Tommie Weckesser (CoH), Anthony Weis (CCSD),

1. Call to Order

- a. Conformance with Nevada Open Meeting Law – The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:30 am. There were enough members present to constitute a quorum.
- b. Introduction of Data Committee members and guests: Attendees introduced themselves.

2. Administrative Action

- a. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- b. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

3. Sub-Committee Reports

a. Mapping Services, Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson IT

The Mapping Services sub-committee finalized Zoning and Transportation mapping services, and they recommended to the Data Committee that GISMO make a link to the free data page so this information can be accessible to the public. This sub-committee will add Planned Land Use, Trails, Schools, Parks, and Building Footprints. They are working on Trails to be the next mapping service available. These are county-wide and not just for the City of Henderson.

A motion was made and seconded to add a web master link to the free data page for Zoning and Transportation. Motion carried.

b. NGIS Symposium, Matt Krok, City of Henderson

The NGIS Symposium planning committee met for the first time last month. They will meet today following the GIS Data Committee Meeting from 11:00 am-12:00 pm in the Sandstone Conference Room just down the hall.

Next year's conference will be May 6-9, with May 7-8 being the actual dates at Sam's Town. There will be activities on May 6 and 9. Let Matt Krok know if you wish to be involved.

NGIS is changing their membership database. As of January 1, the previous membership database will no longer be available. Please go to the new NGIS.org website and create your member profile. Annual membership is \$30. Beginning with the conference this year, videos of the

conference sessions will be available on the website for those unable to attend, so membership is strongly recommended to have access to view these sessions. There is also the ability to sign up under the state connected portion of NGIS.

4. Street Centerline Update, Robert Vega, Clark County IT/GISMO

Last month was the last update for coverages, so we are off the coverage and no more annotations. Street names/field values will be in proper case so if you want them in upper case, you will need to pre-process the data before you put it in your systems. SCL 9 files will be included in the zip. The left zip and the right zip are now the mailing zip codes which should help with geo-coding.

5. Comments by the General Public

Steve Mesa, National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency – Last month we had a meeting with the USDA regarding data collections coming up in the next two weeks. Nellis Air Force Base restricts aircraft that fly into Nellis range. They can go five miles outside the border so we really miss out on a lot of data. We made an agreement with them this year to fly to the border of the Nellis Bombing Range. We are going to start paperwork so that in 2016 they can fly into the range and collect all of the range. I will have some leadership from Nellis come to the next meeting so they understand the need for GIS and aerial imagery.

Craig Hale, Southern Nevada Water Authority – The 2013 imagery project is coming to an end. We completed our initial QA by August 1 for the 1422 tiles. Roughly one-third of the tiles went back for fixes. Goal is for this to be wrapped up tomorrow. I plan to have the data to Robert by Tuesday. Shadows are longer, which is the only real concern I have.

Robert Vega – Since I'm getting the data on Tuesday, I'll start loading the data so I can cache it out. Hopefully it will be done by the end of the week. This will be a new service that we put out for non-server users. Within the next couple of weeks, I'll send out an email for you to look at the aerial photography, pay attention to the shadows, etc, and send me feedback. I will compile the feedback and send to Craig for this year's flight. As Craig mentioned, shadows are long, but you can still see some of the details. Bring it to arc map, zoom around, check it out, and start providing feedback. Remember this is an entire 6" flight. Brian Bolduc will create the ECW's, and Craig Hale may be able to provide SIDS.

Matt Krok, City of Henderson – After 25 years Brendan Lee, City of Henderson, is retiring. This will be his last GIS Data Committee Meeting.

Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson – Matt Krok is assuming a new position with the Fire Department. Today is his last day. We have a lot of changes in the City of Henderson. There is a GIS Analyst I position open until the 29th in Community Development if anyone is interested.

Anthony Weiss, Clark County School District – I have 15 school location maps. If anyone needs additional copies, you can download them from the website.

Hetal Luhar, Southern Nevada Health District – Has septic data been updated?

Robert Vega – We are still working on that. The big thing on the septic layers is trying to figure out how to keep it up-to-date. Jaime McKeown and I will be working on this.

Ken Masden, Clark County Assessor's Office – We're probably going to be in an extended roll close as far as creating parcels until about the 26th of August. The roll reopened and there were some issues. We hope to release parcels in approximately two weeks.

Anthony Willis, City of Las Vegas – Robert Agnew is out on medical leave until October.
