MINUTES

MEMBERS PRESENT: Aaron Baker (Mesquite), Brian Bolduc (CCWRD), Hetal Luhar (SNHD), John Ritsko (RTCSNV/Alternate), Robert Vega (CCIT), Dustin Nelson (CoH/Alternate), Anthony Weis (CCSD), Anthony Willis (CLV)

1. Call to Order

- a. Conformance with Nevada Open Meeting Law – The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:30 am. There were not enough members present to constitute a quorum at the onset of the meeting.
- b. Introduction of Data Committee members and guests: Attendees introduced themselves.

2. Administrative Action

- a. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- b. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

3. Sub-Committee Reports

a. Mapping Services, Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson IT

Committee did not meet – nothing to report.

b. NGIS Symposium, Matt Krok, City of Henderson

No update.

4. 2013 Aerial update, Robert Vega, Clark County IT/GISMO

Per Robert Vega, color balancing filters have been applied to the cache. They are still a little brown and not as contrasted as before; however, they look better than a couple of weeks ago. The adjusted images will be uploaded again. There is no ETA as to when a good version of aerials will come out. If you need raw images, drop off a hard drive. ECWs and SIDS are also available.

5. Street Centerline Update, Robert Vega, Clark County IT/GISMO

At a previous meeting, Robert Vega said that the Street Centerline would be coming from the geo database by the end of September. However, there have been some issues when entering proper case for the street class, so this has been reverted back to upper case. The street names, directions, and types are all in proper case. Street class and derivative layers are in upper case.

Robert suggested doing an inventory of map documents that use those layers and be prepared to make that change. Possibility is to come out with a test dataset to see what it will look like with all in proper case, and then the real dataset will be the current version. Robert may submit a suggestion to ESRI to come up with easier method, possibly make their query case insensitive. Our SDE is going to stay upper case until the end of the year.

6. GIS Data Committee 2014 Discussion

Robert Vega asked if the GIS Data Committee would like to continue with monthly meetings or change to bi-monthly or quarterly. It has been difficult to come up with content for the meetings in the way of discussion topics, presentations, and training. Robert asked for suggestions to be discussed at next month's meeting.

A suggestion was made to cancel meetings on a month-by-month basis if there is nothing to discuss. Robert said that since this is an Open Meeting, there are some logistics that need to be considered, including posting requirements in advance of the meeting. He would need to know by the beginning of the month if we were not going to have a meeting. Robert will look at the calendar and provide the 'drop dead' dates for every month.

"GIS in Action!" is a possible topic for meetings in 2014. Suggestions/ideas are listed below:

7. Comments by the General Public

Robert will gather statistics about old parcel layers that are in the county's SDE system. We may restrict access, rather than deleting them.

Robert Vega responded that we need to update the license manager. Once this has been updated, anyone in the county will be free to go to 10.2.

Hetal Luhar, Southern Nevada Health District – Where are we on septic data?

Robert Vega responded that we may be able to do this in January 2014, as we need to finish up a couple of other projects.

Sonya Wilson, Clark County Department of Aviation –

1. Sonya asked Tony Azua about land use.

Tony responded that he will check on this. There was SE and SW PLU's, and now there should only be SC PLU (South County).

2. Sonya mentioned to those who were using any of the DOA property that was in the central repository for the airport link, it has been out of date for a number of years. They have created a new simplified version and those changes should also reflect in Open Door. This is for the modified deed restrictions for property.

3. Sonya commented that the metadata for 10.2 is like the migration of the previous version of 10 and has not been particularly smooth. The geo processing results stay with the metadata if you have it set to update automatically. These geo processing results cannot be deleted.

Robert suggested that someone with experience in Python and who knows XML may be able to write a script for this.
