MINUTES

MEMBERS PRESENT: Ryan Kammerer (Mesquite), Hetal Luhar (SNHD), Robert Vega (CCIT), Tommie Weckesser (CoH), Anthony Weis (CCSD), Anthony Willis (CLV), Wayne Lindsay (CNLV), Brian Bolduc (CCWRD)

1. Call to Order

- a. Conformance with Nevada Open Meeting Law – The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:30 am. There are eight (8) voting members present so we have a quorum.
- b. Introduction of Data Committee members and guests: Attendees introduced themselves.

2. Administrative Action

- a. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- b. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

3. Sub-Committee Reports

a. Mapping Services, Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson IT

Mapping Services has a Zoning and Landuse service now. Robert Vega has created a directory called Southern Nevada Community Map Services and this is where they are going to start putting all map services. The Zoning and Landuse are for every jurisdiction combined. (Zoning isn't right now, but it's going to be in the next couple weeks). The sub-committee is still working on a Trails Map service. Jeff Truby's map is going to be coming out in April, so they're still refining the data. He's still reaching out to someone to get the Federal data. Then there will be one map for the entire Clark County trails as well as Federal trails.

- ✓ Action Item - A Boulder City Landuse map is missing and Robert Vega will get the name/contact for their Virtual CIO and send it to Tommie.
- ✓ Action Item - Robert will also put a on the GISMO website and will use the same wording as has already been created for Regional Business License and then he will forward it out to all on the sub-committee to tweak for GIS.

b. NGIS Symposium, Matt Krok, City of Henderson

Activities (Time Constraints):

- Test Site Tour – Login and register – Cut off is the beginning of March to get information in for clearance.
- Python Training Class – Tuesday before the Conference – Seats are limited and will fill up quickly.

4. Assessor's Office Data Files, Erik Martinet, Clark County Assessor's Office

Assessor's Office is going to a new CAMA system and our current files are coming from old mainframe application, some of the data hasn't been updated because made switch a couple of weeks/months ago.

Going to maintain the old versions – whatever is in the mainframe is going to get dumped out for the old format. Ownership information, site address and mailing address information on the old AO Extract is valid, anything else after that we can't guarantee it.

Erik is coming up with is a new formatted version of AO Extract. Some of the major changes are field links, which can have an impact on certain things. Also, they are renaming some of the items:

Owner Information: Address 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 go away and they will be Mail Address 1, Mail Address 2, Mail Address 3, City, State, Country and Mail Zip.

Site Address: Street Name is now Location, LOC_

- ✓ Action Item: Robert Vega will include a document with the Minutes that show a before and after of the new structure.

Will support old files, but after new files are up and running, that's what you should be using. Robert will come up with a cut-off date and then give you another month after that and then remove them from the system.

Robert Vega sent out an email to everyone using mailing list and didn't getting any returns. Robert got 6 total responses to the survey he sent out. One Table out of the list is going to be kept and the rest are probably going to get tossed. There are six (6) tables and they are: AO Common, AO Desc, AO SubD, AO Site, AO Condo and AO Symbol.

5. ArcGIS Online, Anthony Willis, City of Las Vegas

What was discussed two meetings ago was that Robert wanted to see GIS data in action. One of the things ESRI is pushing, since they are now giving ArcGIS online credits for free, depending on licensing, is seeing it online. Anthony Willis said that the City of Las Vegas was actually starting to use it and he volunteered to do a presentation.

Anthony Willis, City of Las Vegas, proceeded to present ArcGIS Online. Below are some key highlights from his presentation:

- It's a good product but you have to be careful of what all they tell you it solves.
- You can set up organization and invite users.
- You can set up groups to share – assign work to a group as a publisher or administrator.
- Includes map services – create webmaps & share with organization or group.
- Tagging is very important in this system.
- Completely data driven.
- No annotation - no labeling.
- Templates will work with webmap services.
- It is not an annual subscription, it is a credit based subscription that does not expire and does accumulate.

6. Comments by the General Public

Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson

Tommie commented that she put some flyers up for the NGIF (day after NGIS Conference) being held at the Wildhorse Golf Club at 8:00AM.

Steve Mesa, NGA – Asked if the 2014 aerials are still on track.

Robert responded that the aerial photography was still on the same schedule as discussed last meeting.

Hetal Luhar, Southern Nevada Health District – Asked about the septic layer.

Robert Vega responded that Jaime has been working on the septic layer and he thinks they have a task to publish it now. They are at the point where they are about 90% cleaned up compared to what it was in the past. He should be publishing in the next couple of weeks. He just needs to get the job running so that it does updates. A lot of the stuff we were trying to automate still has to be done manually. In the next couple of week Robert will update the Septic Layer.

- ✓ Robert will send out an email when the septic layer has been updated and on the FTP site.

Wayne Lindsay, City of North Las Vegas – Asked about coverages for the Street Centerline.

Robert responded that they no longer publish coverages for the Street Centerline.

Anthony Willis, City of Las Vegas – Asked about items changes for the SCL.

Robert said that he will look at the SCL but as far as he knows it's the same ones that have always been in the shapefile.

Richard Wells, City of Las Vegas –
