MINUTES

MEMBERS PRESENT: Robert Vega (GISMO), Brian Bolduc (CCWRD), John Ritsko (RTCSNV), Anthony Willis Sr. (CLV), Dustin Nelson (CoH)

1. Call to Order

- a. Conformance with Nevada Open Meeting Law: The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:30 am. There are five (5) voting members present, so we do not have a quorum today.
- b. Introduction of Data Committee Members and Guests: Everyone introduced themselves.

2. Administrative Action

- a. Approval of Agenda: A motion was made and seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- b. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

3. Sub-Committee Reports

a. Mapping Services, Tommie Weckesser, City of Henderson IT

They did not meet, so there is no update at this time.

b. NGIS Symposium Feedback/Comments

One comment regarding this recently held symposium was that it may be better if there were fewer sections which would then allow more time in between sections. Everyone agreed that two days worked out well. Next year's 25th annual symposium will be held in October in Lake Tahoe and then in the Fall each year thereafter. Attendance was good. While there were fewer vendors, overall feedback was good. It was also noted that Robert's Python workshop went well. Robert indicated that he would like to conduct this workshop again next year.

Future symposium schedule will move to the Fall versus Spring. 2015 NGIS will be the 25th anniversary symposium and will be held at Lake Tahoe. This symposium will continue to be held in the Fall from 2015 forward.

4. Data Clean-up, Robert Vega, Clark County GISMO

Robert indicated that we are making good progress. Everyone should have received an e-mail with a spreadsheet from Jaime McKeown requesting whether or not data on the spreadsheet was current. We've received about 90% of replies back. In September, we will begin to plan to clean up. Anyone who has not replied back yet should do so as soon as possible.

There is some extra data on the servers that's not on the downloads. This extra data is maintained on the servers so we can access it if/as needed. We have water district data that has not been updated since 2001. GISMO has a lot of data that we're not even sure what it is. We will archive old data in case we need some of this data back.

So, we are trying to clean up the central repository, get up-to-date, and get rid of old data. We have a lot of old data that we will either update or discard (archive).

We need to figure out a transition plan from old assessor data to new CAMA based data. Everyone should be using the new CAMA. AOExtract_ is the newest from CAMA system in SDE and is in the download section. AOEXTWDB_CAMA is the newest version of AO Extract that we have. By the August meeting, we should have a transition plan to show everyone how we plan to go from current underscore names back to the old names.

Action Item:

- ✓ Robert will send out spreadsheet showing everyone's status with regards to this.

5. Aerial Photography, Craig Hale, SNWA

Craig discussed that we should be receiving large deliveries starting next week. They started flying the second week of March (14 through 16). That encompassed the Valley east of Eastern. They did not get back up for another three weeks. Beginning April 5 through the 14, they started acquiring everything else. So, essentially, about 85% imagery was collected early. Quality is better than it's been in the past, with sharper images and far fewer shadows.

We have a dozen samples in and everything looks pretty good. We have the same issues as we've had with other vendors regarding transition of urban and desert areas and we work with them to correct these. Colors should be more natural.

We should start see this sometime next week and getting much bigger sets. We are still on schedule for August 15 acceptance.

Craig will send out more frequent updates as we start seeing imagery.

6. Other Projects, Robert Vega, Clark County GISMO

- OpenWeb (OW)/OpenDoor (OD) Conversion from Silverlight to Javascript: Robert discussed that we are working on conversion of OW/OD from Silverlight API over to

Javascript using ESRI's Javascript api. We are going to use clear bootstrap template, angular for NBC framework and ESRI framework as it is. This is still a work in progress and will be a 12-18 month project.

- Comprehensive Planning Notification Project: Robert discussed that Jaime is working on this. She is learning about Python, processes and user input. After this learning period, she will then have Python based projects.
- ArcGIS Server Upgrades: We are now at 10.1 and need to figure out how to upgrade to 10.2.2. By September, the County will be at 10.2.2 on all desktops. So, there won't be any more coverages or ArcInfo work stations. Robert indicated that our Web servers are still 2008 R2 and that we are good for a few years.
- BLITZ Project: We are negotiating with the vendor and GIS will play a big role in this. We will be working with the Assessor's Office to rework how they do parcels so we can support permitting systems. This project will begin over the next couple of months.

7. Comments by the General Public
