ANNOUNCEMENT FOR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

The Clark County Fire Department occupies an area of 8,012 square miles and has the largest paid fire department (29 stations) and the largest Volunteer force (13 stations) in the state of Nevada.

Volunteer firefighters responded to 1,741 incidents in 2011 and 3,272 incidents in 2012. Because of the growing responses in the rural areas, the Clark County Fire Department is reaching out to Clark County residents to become Volunteer Fire Fighters / Emergency Medical Services personnel.

The minimum requirements for the Volunteer position are:

Education

High School Graduate or GED equivalent

Pre-Volunteer Acceptance Testing

Must successfully pass a background investigation

Must successfully pass a physical examination

Must successfully pass the Entry Level Firefighter Course

Licenses

Must possess a valid Class C Nevada driver's license

In addition to the above requirements you must also be able to commit to 24 hours of volunteer service a month for a minimum of two (2) years.
