


MAP OF THE CLARK COUNTY LAW LIBRARY

- ALRs (American Law Reports)** - Are on your right as you enter the library.
- Bathrooms** - Are located to the left of the Reference Desk against the back wall. FOLLOW THE SIGNS to easily locate them.
- Digests** - Are located to your right as you enter the library.
- Nevada Collection** - The Nevada area of the library holds the Nevada Revised Statutes (our state laws), legislative journals, and other material on the subject of Nevada. As you enter the library the tall Nevada shelves are visible to your right.
- Public Computers** - The public computers that are used with database CDs are on the left side of the Reference Desk as you enter the library. These are also used for word-processing of documents. Ask for the desired CD at the Reference Desk. The public Internet computers are on the right as you enter the library. Please bring a photo ID for all computer usage.
- Reference** - The reference area of the library is near the center of the library. As you enter the library the reference section is plainly visible on short shelves to your left.
- Reporters** - Contain decisions from courts of various jurisdictions at both state Supreme Court and federal levels. The reporter section of the library is on your right as you enter.
- State Codes** - There are two sets of the NRS on shelf #1 within the Nevada section of the library. California and Arizona state codes are located in the reference section. The other state codes are available using one of the four Internet computers directly in front of shelf #1 of the Nevada section.
- Treatises** - Are sources of "secondary authority" and usually cover subjects in much the same manner as any book would cover a subject. As you enter the library the shelves holding the treatises are to your left, plainly visible on tall shelves marked with letters of the alphabet. The treatises are shelved in call number order.
