

FEDERAL INTERNET RESEARCH

There are many Federal government sources available. Some of these include Federal courts, Federal laws, Federal codes, and Federal regulations. The Clark County Law Library has created a list of links to assist you in legal research at www.ClarkCountyNV.Gov/LawLibrary.

TIMELINESS OF SOURCES

Always check the currentness and coverage of the website. Many sources will only go back a few years. The older the information, the less likely it is to be on the Internet.

SEARCHING

When searching using a word or phrase the computer will look for exact matches. If a word does not match the words in text **exactly**, no results will be found. Therefore, try a variety of search terms. Use a thesaurus or legal dictionary to locate additional search terms if needed.

RAPID GROWTH OF THE INTERNET

The number of Internet sites is rapidly growing. Due to this rapid growth, sites are constantly changing. Sites can leave the Internet as quickly as they are created. They also change URLs and content frequently. It is impossible for the library to keep track of all these changes, so keep this in mind if you cannot find a site.
