COMPENSATION SCHEDULE

The Public Administrator may protect property of individuals who die in Clark County when a family member or legal representative is not available to do so or if property determined to have value to the estate is deemed to be at risk. Pursuant to NRS 253.050(3), the Public Administrator is entitled to compensation from the estate or from beneficiaries for the reasonable value of services provided before the appointment of an administrator; this compensation is set by the Board of County Commissioners and subsequently paid into the Clark County General Fund.
