REFUND POLICY

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

Refunds will be issued only after an effort is made to accommodate a user by transfer to similar program or facility. Refunds will be available on the criteria within this policy, specifically listed below.

Classes & Programs: If a class or program is cancelled by the department a full refund will be made. Class registration may be cancelled by an individual:
100% refund if cancellation is made prior to the close of the first day of class.
No refund may be made after the first day of class.

Day Camp: Registration cancelled by individual will be refunded 100% if notice is given by the Wednesday of the prior week.

Memberships & Passes: Monthly, quarterly or annual passes will be refunded on a prorated basis, based on time remaining on pass.

Special Events, Field Trips & Monday Fundays: Registration cancelled by an individual shall not be refunded for any ticketed events or activities which require Clark County to pre-purchase/pre-arrange costs (i.e. tickets, food, supplies and materials or vendor with a quantity based contract).

***Please Note:** Refunds may take six (6) to eight (8) weeks to process.
