Host Program

If you have an RV, enjoy the great outdoors and would like to enjoy the Shooting Park, the Host Program may provide you with a great experience! Nestled at the base of the Sheep Mountain Range in Fabulous Las Vegas, not far from the lights and sounds of the Las Vegas Strip, sits the World-Class Clark County Shooting Park. The Shooting Park is currently looking for individuals to serve in its Host Program.



Duties

A Clark County Shooting Park Host assists program supervisors at the Shooting Park with the needs of the park including, but not limited to, assisting with grounds upkeep, park maintenance, custodial, and park operations. A Shooting Park host should also expect to assist park staff with duties as a line safety officer and other duties associated with Shooting Park safety and park maintenance.

Amenities

A park host lives on site at the Shooting Park in the Host Area, comprised of 30-full length covered RV sites with a patio, concrete pad, private BBQ grill, picnic table, and a community picnic area. Each site includes water, sewer, and electrical 50 AMP service and access to laundry facilities and showers. Internet and phone service is available at the Host's expense.

Host Eligibility

To be eligible to be a Clark County Shooting Park Host you must:

- Be 21 yrs or older
- Own your own RV
- Live on site at the Clark County Shooting Park
- Perform at least 15 hours of hosting duties per week
- Perform light to moderate physical labor

Applicants must meet the qualifications of the Clark County Parks & Recreation Department Volunteer

Ambassador Program. This also includes completion of a successful background check and interview.

The Clark County Shooting Park is a recreational shooting range. It is not an appropriate place for resident children. Applicants with resident children or resident grandchildren under 18 years of age are not eligible for the Shooting Park Host Program.



Shooting Park Hosts may have children or grandchildren visitors for no more than two weeks visitation if advance approval is obtained through the Park Office. Junior visitors must be supervised by the Park Host and may not enter other areas of the shooting park without adult supervision.



Application Process

1. Each applicant may access and complete the Individual Ambassador On-line Application from the Parks and Recreation Webpage:




2. Applicants should indicate Shooting Park HOST PROGRAM when prompted for the position of interest. Please include a working e-mail address, working telephone number.
3. Processed applications are forwarded to the Shooting Park.
4. The Shooting Park will contact the volunteer host applicant, and mail the Clark County Shooting Park Host Program Information, Shooting Park Host Application, and the Clark County Background Release and Authorization form to prospective hosts along with a self-addressed envelope to return completed materials.
5. Once a County Background Release and Authorization is approved an interview is scheduled.
6. Once the Host is approved and arrives at the Shooting Park office the host applicant must complete the check-in process.
7. When the Host completes the check-in process they are referred to the Host specialist for training and badging.

*Note: An individual cannot volunteer at any County function until the background check is processed, completed, and the host receives a County Volunteer Ambassador Badge.

Wednesday through Sunday


Patrons should check-in at the Shotgun Center for shotgun and archery, and the Rifle-Pistol Center for rifle-pistol shooting.
