



PUBLIC MODULE

Clark County Shooting Park

The target completion date for the Public Module is Fall 2009. This module is designed to provide immediate public shooting opportunities to the citizens of Clark County.

- **Access Roadway:** The roadway to access the park will be one mile of Decatur Blvd beginning at the Iron Mountain sub station and continuing North to the park site. This roadway includes a box culvert, water, electrical and phone conduits, fencing, and retaining walls.
- **Internal Roadway:** CCSP will contain approximately three (3) miles of internal paved roadways.
- **Water System:** The water system at CCSP consists of an approximately two-mile long water line with a pump station from the City of North Las Vegas Reservoir at Moccasin Road and Decatur Blvd. This pump station services the 55,000-gallon reservoir located at the Northeast corner of the property and all the water lines for the public module.
- **Park Entrance:** The entrance to the park contains a traffic circle, esthetic monuments, and two electric access gates.
- **Park Office:** The CCSP Park Office is a 2,000 square foot building where CCSP Staff offices will be located and feature an area reserved for public parking. It also contains a public informational kiosk area.
- **Maintenance Area:** This is a secured compound with a 1500sqft storage area.
- **Host Site:** The Host Site consists of a 30-site, full service area for the CCSP Host Program.
- **Archery Center:** The Archery Center houses a known-distance archery range, covered firing points, classroom area, restrooms, and shade ramadas.
- **Shotgun Center:** This feature contains 24 combination Trap and Skeet fields, a 5,443 square foot shotgun center with a reception area, a pro shop, shotgun storage lockers and a cafeteria. It also features 80 full-service RV sites, a clay target storage building, lit ranges and shade ramadas.
- **Public Rifle/Pistol Center:** The Public Rifle/Pistol Center offers 30 shooting points up to 50 yards; 15 shooting points up to 200 yards; 15 points up to 100 yards, night lights, shade ramadas, concrete shooting tables, covered shooting areas, a 3,000 square foot building with a convenience store, a reception area, a 30 seat classroom, restrooms and a pro shop.
- **Hunter Education Center:** This 4,400 square foot building contains three 30-seat classrooms expandable up to one 90-seat classroom, two offices for NDOW use, and restrooms. It also features night lighting, a 100-meter archery range with 10 positions, a 100-yard range with 10 positions, and a 50-yard range with 20 positions. It will also contain a shotgun range and two walking field courses.
