

COLORADO RIVER HERITAGE GREENWAY (CRHG) PARK AND TRAILS HOST PROGRAM

If you have an RV, enjoy working with people and would like to enjoy a beautiful desert park and trails, the Clark County Host Program may provide you with an ideal experience! The Clark County CRHG Park is a recreational facility with a multi-use trail system, encompassing nearly 1,200 acres. Nestled at the base of the Davis Dam along the Colorado River in Laughlin, Nevada the CRHG Park provides opportunities for picnics, fishing, hiking, and horseback riding in an area offering stunning views in every direction. The CRHG Park is currently looking for individuals to serve in its Host Program. The purpose of this volunteer host position is to provide the public with information, monitor the condition of the facilities and perform some maintenance duties within the park and trails.

DUTIES

Clark County CRHG Park Hosts assist Parks and Recreation Department program staff with the needs of the park and trails including, but not limited to:

- Monitoring the daily/weekly usage reports for the facility.
- Providing excellent customer service to visitors in the park.
- Providing maintenance/custodial cleaning as directed.
- Opening and closing of facility gates.
- Reviewing current picnic permits for assigned rental areas.
- Walking and checking paths/trails and removing trash.
- Acting as an emergency contact to report maintenance, security and safety issues.
- Assisting County staff with any programs/events as assigned.
- Providing for any other duties as assigned.

AMENITIES

CRHG Park hosts are required to live on site . Three host sites are comprised of a 30 foot full-length covered RV site with a concrete pad and use of the community picnic area. The three host sites include water, sewer and electrical 50 AMP service.

One host site at the Equestrian Trail Head does not have sewer and water hook ups, therefore, the Host RV unit must be self-contained and may periodically utilize hook ups at a neighboring site as designated.

HOST ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to be a Clark County CRHG Park Host you must:

- Be 21 years or older
- Provide your own RV with current vehicle registration, as required
- Live on site at the Clark County CRHG Park
- Perform at least 28 hours of hosting duties per week
- Perform light to moderate physical labor in an outdoor setting
- Be available for one of the 4 month assignments (January-April/May-August/September-December).

Applicants must meet the qualifications of the Clark County Parks & Recreation Department Volunteer Program. This includes completion of a successful background check and interview. This residential host program does not provide for resident children. Applicants with resident children under 18 years of age are not eligible to participate in the CRHG Park Host Program. CRHG Park Hosts may have junior visitors for no more than two weeks of visitation with advance approval from the Clark County Parks and Recreation Department. Junior visitors must be supervised by the CRHG Park Host and may not enter other areas of the CRHG Park without adult supervision.

APPLICATION PROCESS

2. Applicants should indicate CRHG PARK HOST PROGRAM as the position of interest. Please include a working e-mail address as well as a working telephone number.
3. Completed applications will be forwarded for processing.
4. Parks and Recreation staff will contact the volunteer host applicant, and mail the Clark County CRHG Park Host Program information, CRHG Park Host Application, and the Clark County Background Release and Authorization form to prospective hosts.
5. Once notice of a successful background check is received by staff, an interview is scheduled with the prospective host.
6. Upon notification of selection, the Host is to schedule an appointment with staff at the Laughlin Parks & Recreation Office and complete the check-in process.
7. Upon completion of the check-in process, Host will receive training and directions to obtain a Clark County volunteer badge. *Note: An individual cannot volunteer at, or for, any County function until the background check is processed, completed, and the host receives a County Volunteer Badge.
