

**Norman L. White**

**Elected 1960**

**Norman L. White came to Clark County following World War II and settled in the Paradise Valley area where he worked as a television salesman. He served just one term on the Clark County Commission.**

**He served as chairman of the Paradise Valley Improvement Association. He also was a member of the Clark County Planning Commission.**

**In 1958, White ran for the Nevada State Assembly on a platform of increasing appropriation to southern Nevada, improving schools, and eliminating the sales tax on food and drugs. He lost in the primary.**

**White ran for the Clark County Commission in 1960 citing his record with the Paradise Valley Improvement Association and getting a fire station and school for the area. He ran for reelection for the board in 1962, but lost. In 1964, White was named to fill a vacancy on the Clark County Sanitation Board.**
