Susan Brager has made southern Nevada her home for over forty years, of which she has spent more than two decades working tirelessly to improve the public school system. In 2006, she won the District F seat on the Clark County Commission, representing 325,000 constituents in the southwest area of the valley.



Beginning in 1972, Brager became involved with the local public schools through volunteering with the PTA and other boards and committees. She was also employed by the Clark County School District in a variety of positions.

In 1990, Brager ran for the school board, however, she narrowly lost the election. She ran again in 1994 on a platform of improving occupational and vocational education and won her first of three terms on the school board.

She has also served on a number of community boards including as chairman of the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition, president of Spring Valley Bobby Sox Softball, and on the Clark County Parks and Recreation Board. In addition, she has worked as a realtor in Las Vegas since 1989.

In 2006, Brager ran for the Clark County Commission against Lynette Boggs on a platform of providing stability for the board and improved foresight and planning for the county. She won the election and was sworn in on January 2, 2007 for a four-year term. In January 2009 she was chosen to be Vice-Chair.

Brager was selected to serve on the Nevada Development Authority, Family & Juvenile Justice Services Policy and Fiscal Affairs Board, Southern Nevada District Board of Health and Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition. She also serves on the boards of the University Medical Center, Las Vegas Valley Water District, Clark County Water Reclamation District and Liquor and Gaming Licensing Board.

Brager is married to Ron Wellman and has three children and eleven grandchildren.
