- Cornerstone Program customer base program

C. Parks Vandalism and Graffiti Costs – Steven Corry

- \$192,512.76 amount spent on vandalism and graffiti for last FY

- Total of 110 thousand dollars losses in wire theft for FY '07
- Work closely with Park Police Division
- Active Park Ambassadors Program at Desert Breeze, Sunset and Whitney
