Program Overview

The main focus of the Safekey Summer Camp program is to provide a safe and fun environment for participants that offers a wide variety of indoor and outdoor recreational activities. Activities include arts & crafts, entertainment, tournaments, sports, movies, field trips, and more!

What do parents need to know?



- The Safekey Summer Camps are designed for children ages 6 - 12.
- Participants are required to bring a lunch and two snacks that do not require heating or refrigeration.
- Available sites are open to all students with no zoning restrictions.
- All parties must follow the Parent/Participant Guidelines. No exceptions.

What does Safekey Summer Camp Cost?

- \$18 per day. *Please refer to the information in blue for registration and payment information.*
- As space permits, days purchased may be used for any day during the Summer Camp Program.
- Field trips will be offered at an additional fee, *first come, first served*. Participants planning to go on scheduled field trips are required to purchase a t-shirt at a cost of \$5 each. Summer Camp t-shirts may be purchased in advance with mail-in or walk-in registration.
- At 6:01 pm, a late pick-up fee of \$5 will be assessed for every ten minutes that the participant remains at the site.
- If your child/children remain at the site until 8:01 P.M., Metro Police will be called to transport the participant to Child Haven. If this occurs, you may call Child Haven at (702) 455-9390 to make arrangements to pick up your child.
- After 3 late pick-ups, your child/children will not be allowed to return to the program.

How do I reserve a spot for my child?

- The first two weeks must be paid in full with initial registration.
- Payment is due by 6 PM each Wednesday to reserve your spot for the upcoming week.
- For periodic attendance, payment in full is required for each anticipated day of attendance.
- Drop-ins are welcome, if space is available.

The Safekey Summer Camps are extremely Popular; please remember space is limited. Registration is processed in the order received.

REMINDER: PARENT/GUARDIAN MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF PAYMENT TO THE SAFEKEY SITE STAFF PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION.

INSUFFICIENT FUNDS

- After one returned check, payment must be made by cash/money order or credit cards only. **Once notified, the parent must pay the amount of the check plus a \$25 fee** before your child can return to the program.

IF ANY BALANCES ARE DUE, YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE SAFEKEY PROGRAM OR ANY OTHER PROGRAM OFFERED BY CLARK COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION.

CREDIT/REFUND

- Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Safekey Summer Camp staff **prior to the end of Summer Camp**; requests after the completion of Summer Camp will not be accepted.
- No refunds are granted for time missed due to disciplinary measures, including suspension, expulsion and/or trespass of participant, parent/guardian or escorts.

SAFEKEY SIGN-IN AND SIGN-OUT PROCEDURES

- Parents/guardians or authorized individuals that are listed on the participant information form are required to sign their child in and out of the program daily.
- A government issued picture ID is required each time you or an authorized person arrives to pick up your child. **There are no exceptions.**

HEALTH & MEDICATION

- Please help us maintain a healthy environment by keeping your child home when he/she is sick.
- All medication, including over the counter drugs, need to be physician prescribed, labeled in the original container, and accompanied by a completed medication request form by the guardian.
- Safekey Staff cannot dispense or administer any type of medication.
- Any food allergies must be indicated on the registration form.



INJURY/EMERGENCY ISSUES

- An Incident/Accident Report form will be completed for injuries and staff will make every effort to contact the injured participant's parent/guardian.
 - Call the Safekey Administration Office at (702) 455-8251 for more information about obtaining a copy of the report.
- In case of emergency, it is critical that all information on the Registration Form be kept current.**

- In cases of extreme emergencies or a life threatening injury, the following will occur in this order:
 - 9-1-1 will be called
 - Staff will call parent/guardian; if the parent/guardian cannot be reached, additional contacts as listed on the participant's registration form will be called.

NOTE: Verbal authorization may be given by the parent/guardian via telephone to emergency responders for transport. The parent/guardian will be liable for all emergency transportation costs.


INCLUSION
