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- B. Doug Nielsen, NV Department of Wildlife, refers to the Proforma and questions if the numbers in the financial presentation is based on the master plan at full build out or the 30% build out that it is now in operations.
- C. Karen Semplinski, CCSC supporter questions why the range isn't run like a business and the ability to purchase retail food and beverage items as needed.
- D. Tom Cost, volunteer at CCSC suggests working with the Las Vegas Convention & Visitors Authority (LVCVA) to create a 10 second PSA, to advertise coast to coast throughout the U.S.
- E. James Borchers, part-time staff at CCSC, suggests advertising to get people to the complex, maybe lower prices to sell RV sites and advertising at the Rifle-Pistol center. Suggests offering annual memberships to acquire money up front, similar to gym memberships. Customers want a sense of belonging to a group.
- F. John Cahill, Public Administrator encourages the public to make comments at the Board of County Commission meetings. Maybe this is the time to let BCC know that we documented relevance of 10 yrs and within the 5 yrs of operations, the forecast is that CCSC is not being treated like McCarran Airport Enterprise Funds.
