Welcome to the Clark County Shooting Park

After 24 years of citizen efforts, the first phase of the Clark County Shooting Park is now open. The Public Module is designed to meet the needs of the citizens of Clark County in providing safe and affordable recreational shooting. On the shooting park master plan, the yellow areas highlight the Public Module which is in operation.



The shooting park site is located on 2,900 acres. Development of the actual shooting areas, however, is much smaller. A larger area was planned to provide a buffer around the shooting areas and provide increased safety. The Public Module presently encompasses 178 acres, and the entire build out will utilize approximately 900 acres. The rest of the 2,000 acres is being managed as a natural desert area and is protected from off road vehicle damage, random shooting, and criminal activities that previously occurred on the property. This modern shooting park has been designed to protect the environment while providing safe shooting opportunities for the public and complies with all federal, state, and local codes and ordinances. It is estimated that 45% of the households in Clark County own a firearm. This is the only public shooting range in southern Nevada.

User Groups offer practice and competitive events, as well as firearms and archery skill building and safety courses through our scheduling process. Master Plan

The Clark County Shooting Park is designed to be built in three phases. The current phase, the Public Module, is designed to provide safe recreational shooting to the citizens and visitors in Clark County, NV.

The remaining two phases of construction are the Events Module and the Service Module. The Clark County Shooting Park in conjunction with Nevada Law Enforcement Agencies will build Law Enforcement Training and Firearms Facilities as funds are available.



Public Shooting Fees
