Beretta Firearms Now Renting at Nevada's 5-Star Outdoor Shooting Complex

A rental fleet of some of the world's best guns – high-quality, target-grade Beretta firearms – has arrived at Nevada's 5-Star Outdoor Shooting Complex.

"We finally have 5-star rental equipment to match our 5-star shooting facility," said complex Administrator Steve Carmichael. "I'd like to encourage everyone to come visit us and shoot these incredible guns or buy a holiday gift certificate for a friend or loved one."

An exclusive agreement between Beretta U.S.A. Corp. and the Clark County Shooting Complex was approved on Sept. 16 by the Clark County Commission, allowing the world-class firearms manufacturer to provide a fleet of high-quality, target-grade shotguns, handguns and rifles in various calibers and gauges.

"Residents and tourists of Las Vegas can now enjoy the experience of sport shooting with Beretta firearms recognized for their design, quality and ease of use," said Commissioner Tom Collins, who represents the area where the complex is located. "Everyone should come out for a fun-filled family day and enjoy the perfect weather we've been having this holiday season!"

During the holidays, locals bring their out-of-town guests of all ages to the complex to experience the shooting sports offered at the facility, including trap and skeet, sporting clays, rifle-pistol, and archery. Also available at the Shooting Complex are gift certificates, a big hit during the holiday season for those looking to buy holiday gifts for family and friends.

"Clark County's Shooting Complex is an excellent place for experienced shooters, as well as for those new to sport shooting," said Joe Tinghitella, Territory Manager, West Region for Beretta U.S.A. Corp. "The variety of shooting disciplines, various ranges, and education and safety instruction courses make this a state-of-the-art facility for those of all ages to enjoy."

The partnership is the first cooperative agreement for the Clark County Shooting Complex. It acknowledges Beretta as the official sponsor of the complex's rental operations, and pro shop sales of accessories and safety equipment. The Shooting Complex is responsible for the maintenance of the Beretta firearms for rentals and instruction.

"This partnership is a first for Southern Nevada," said Commissioner Collins. "Pairing Nevada's incredible 5-Star facility with Beretta, a world-renowned gun manufacturer, is nothing short of a coup."

The 5-star designation is from the respected National Shooting Sports Foundation, which awarded the Clark County Shooting Complex its highly sought-after 5-star rating in 2010. The complex is one of only 11 outdoor facilities around the country with this designation (there are 40 total with the designation in the United States). Facilities can earn up to five stars based on an evaluation of six criteria: appearance, customer/member focus, customer/member development, management, community relations and amenities.

“This is one of the best-kept secrets in Las Vegas, this beautiful jewel of a facility just north of the 215 on N. Decatur that boasts a 270-panoramic view of the Las Vegas Valley due to its elevated setting,” said Carmichael. “Those looking to try a new experience and have a good time in a safe and controlled environment will enjoy an impressive menu of sport shooting options.”

In February, officials launched a public outreach campaign to raise awareness of the Shooting Complex using billboards, television spots, print and digital ads, social media, and a new logo. Today, the campaign continues to draw an increased interest in recreational shooting and new shooters to the complex.

Details about Clark County Shooting Complex offerings:

- Archery - The Archery Center is equipped with two outdoor archery ranges. The first is a known- distance range with a large canopy providing adequate shade for archers and spectators. It hosts 80 shooting lanes with targets ranging from 20 feet to 100 yards. The second range is a 3D Animal Archery Course, a beautiful, all-natural desert landscaped, 2.4-mile trail. The trail features shooting lanes with distances ranging from 15 yards to 60 yards. The 3D animal targets are as small as coyotes or javelina and as large as big horn sheep and full-size mule deer.
- Sporting Clays - The 75-acre, 30-station sporting clays course features three shooting positions at each station for a total of 90. Sporting clays is a form of clay pigeon shooting that is designed to simulate the unpredictability of shooting live birds, offering numerous target flight presentations with variations in speed, distance, elevation and target size.
- Shotgun Center - This feature contains 24 combination Trap and Skeet fields, a 5,443-square-foot shotgun center with a reception area, a pro shop, shotgun storage lockers and a cafeteria. It also features 80 full-service RV sites, a clay target storage building, lit ranges and shade ramadas.
- Rifle-Pistol Center - The public Rifle-Pistol Center offers 30 shooting points up to 50 yards; 15 shooting points up to 200 yards; 15 points up to 100 yards, night lights, shade ramadas, concrete shooting tables, covered shooting areas, a 3,000-square-foot building with a convenience store, a reception area, a 30-seat classroom, restrooms and a pro shop.
- Education Center -This 4,400-square-foot building contains three 30-seat classrooms expandable up to one 90-seat classroom, two offices for Nevada Department of Wildlife use and restrooms. It also features night lighting, a 100-meter archery range with 10 positions, a 100-yard range with 10 positions, and a 50-yard range with 20 positions. It includes a shotgun range and two walking field courses for hunter education.
- Camper Host Site - The Host Site consists of a 30-full-service RV hook up area for the Host Program.

The Clark County Shooting Complex winter hours of operation from Nov. 1 through Feb. 28 are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursdays through Sundays, and 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Wednesdays.
