### HISTORY OF THE CLARK COUNTY SHOOTING COMPLEX

The shooting complex is a culmination of community and citizen advisory, state, local and national government efforts. The concept of a public shooting facility for the citizens of Las Vegas and surrounding areas was first created in the early 1980s.

### ADDRESSING PUBLIC SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

Public safety is the number one priority of the Clark County Shooting Complex. Each building and shooting range was designed with the intention to be operated as a safe shooting site. Clark County received a highly esteemed EPA recognition for its Environmental Stewardship Program. Prior to construction, the County completed botanical, wildlife and paleontological studies and implemented a lead mitigation plan to address potential concerns.
