Nevada's 5-Star Outdoor Shooting Facility One of the best-kept secrets in Las Vegas

The Clark County Shooting Complex celebrates its fifth year anniversary in March. The complex was developed through the combined efforts of the community, a citizen's advisory committee, and state, local and federal governments. The \$65 million facility design includes three phases starting with the public module, which currently provides safe recreational shooting to residents and visitors in the Las Vegas Valley.

Today, the shooting complex is host to some of the largest shooting competitions in the country. The Ducks Unlimited Continental Shoot was held at the complex from Feb. 12-15 for a second consecutive year after outgrowing a previous facility. More than 445 shotgun participants from around the country competed for \$75,000 in prizes including Browning shotguns and Fiocchi ammo prize packages. Ducks Unlimited will return to the shooting complex in February 2016 with what promises to be an even larger event.

The National Sporting Clays Association held the largest sporting clays shooting championship in the 14-state western region from Oct. 2-5, 2014 with more than 420 registered competitors.

“We’re thrilled to be hosting these competitions and events,” said complex Administrator Steve Carmichael. “As more organizations and clubs find out that we can accommodate their events and cater to their specific needs, the complex will quickly become known as a premier venue for sport shooting.”

Other events hosted at the complex in 2014 included the U.S. Open Youth Clay Shooting Championship, the largest youth shooting competition in the Western United States, with more than 500 boys and girls in grades 4-12 in July. And in March, Fiocchi sponsored the Silver Buckle sporting clays tournament with more than 155 competitors representing 20 states.

On Sept. 16, 2014, an exclusive agreement between Beretta U.S.A. Corp. and the shooting complex was approved on Sept. 16, 2014 by the Clark County Commission, allowing the world-class firearms manufacturer to provide a rental fleet of high-quality, target-grade shotguns, handguns and rifles in various calibers and gauges.

“We finally have 5-star rental equipment to match our 5-star shooting facility,” said Carmichael. “I encourage everyone to come visit us and shoot these incredible guns.”

The partnership is the first cooperative agreement for the Clark County Shooting Complex. It acknowledges Beretta as the official sponsor of the complex’s rental operations, and pro shop sales of accessories and safety equipment. The Shooting Complex is responsible for the maintenance of the Beretta firearms for rentals and instruction.

“Clark County’s Shooting Complex is an excellent place for experienced shooters, as well as for those new to sport shooting,” said Joe Tinghitella, Territory Manager, West Region for Beretta U.S.A. Corp. “The variety of shooting disciplines, various ranges, and education and safety instruction courses make this a state-of-the-art facility for those of all ages to enjoy.”

The shooting complex offers a 75-acre, 30-station sporting clays course; 24 combination trap and skeet fields; a 5,443-square-foot shotgun center with a pro shop and 80 full-service RV sites; an archery center with a known-distance range and a 3D Animal Archery Course; a rifle-pistol center with 30 shooting points up to 50 yards, 15 shooting points up to 100 yards and 15 shooting points up to 200 yards; a 4,400-square-foot Education Center with three 30-seat classrooms expandable up to one 90-seat classroom and archery and shotgun ranges, and two walking field courses for hunter education; and, a Camper Host Site with 30 full-service RV hook ups.

“This is one of the best-kept secrets in Las Vegas, this beautiful jewel of a facility that boasts a 270-panoramic view of the Las Vegas Valley due to its elevated setting,” said Carmichael. “Those looking to try a new experience and have a good time in a safe and controlled environment will enjoy an impressive menu of sport shooting options.”





Famous John Mull's Meats Opens Second 'Road Kill Grill' at Shooting Complex

The Clark County Shooting Complex can now add the famous Road Kill Grill to its list of amenities. John Mull's Meats celebrated the grand opening of Road Kill Grill II on Feb. 12. Clark County Commissioner Tom Collins and John Mull's Meats Owner John C. "Chuck" Frommer hosted a ribbon cutting ceremony to mark the opening.

"This is nothing short of a coup to have the food operation at the shooting complex run by none other than Mull's Meats owner Chuck Frommer," said County Commissioner Tom Collins. "Chuck's grandfather, John Mulls, would be very proud of his grandson for expanding the popular Road Kill Grill to the shooting complex."

Popularity of John Mull's Meats' Road Kill Grill located at 3730 Thom Blvd. in Las Vegas exploded after Food Network star Guy Fieri featured Road Kill Grill on *Diners, Drive-ins and Dives* in May 2012. Frommer occupied the food operation and concession at the shooting complex in January and named it 'Road Kill Grill II'. The menu includes meats prepared BBQ style in giant-sized smokers including brisket, pulled pork, pulled chicken, hot links, ribs and a variety of side dishes.

"We couldn't ask for a better time to hold the grand opening of Road Kill Grill II, which was on the opening day of the Ducks Unlimited Continental Shoot," said shooting complex Administrator Steve Carmichael. "Serving the best BBQ in the Las Vegas Valley, the grill served breakfast and lunch to more than 1,000 competitors and guests during the sunny, four-day event from Feb. 12-15."

Road Kill Grill II is open during public shooting hours from Wednesday to Sunday. Breakfast is served on Saturday's and Sunday's from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m.
