Day of the Dead Juried Exhibition Drop-off/Pick-up information for ARTISTS

Artists must be residents of Clark County and at least 14 years old to enter.

Each artist may submit up to three works.

All media are welcome, but works must fit through a standard doorframe.
Two-dimensional works must be ready to hang with wire or d-hooks in place.

Artists are advised to learn Day of the Dead traditions, which honor the dead, but also confront death itself, often with a humorous attitude. Day of the Dead is not to be confused with Halloween.

DROP-OFF

To be considered for the exhibit, all works must be brought to Winchester Gallery.

Work will be accepted only on:

Tuesday, Oct .13 10 a.m. & 8.p.m and Wednesday, Oct.14 between 10 a.m. & 8 p.m.

NOTIFICATION

Selected artists will be notified **by email only** about the status of their submissions on **Sunday, October 15, 2015. Exhibit dates 10/20- 11/05.**

PICK-UP

Artwork not juried into the show must be picked up on Thursday, October 15, 2015 between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

If a special arrangement needs to be made please contact center staff but Winchester is not responsible for condition of work that is not picked up on October 15, 2015.

Artwork juried into the show must be picked up on Thursday, November 5 between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.

All artists juried into the exhibition and the Best of Show winner will be recognized on Sunday, Nov. 1 at 6 p.m. in the gallery during the Day of the Dead festivities.
