REQUIREMENTS

You must have resided in Nevada for two years prior to filing for bankruptcy to use Nevada exemption laws. You also cannot discharge certain debts in a bankruptcy, like child support or alimony obligations, some personal injury and criminal penalty money judgments, and some tax and student loan debt.

DIRECTIONS

The Clark County Law Library is located in downtown Las Vegas, between Bridger Ave. and Lewis Ave. It is on the east side of Third Street. **Please allow additional time to find parking.**

From I-15, take the East Charleston exit. Travel east on Charleston, turn left (north) on 4th Street, turn left on Lewis, turn right on 3rd Street. Destination is on your right.

From I-95, take the So. Las Vegas Blvd. exit. Travel south on Las Vegas Blvd., turn right on Bridger Ave., turn left on 3rd Street. Destination is on your left.
