Bookmark reading logs may be picked up at the Library starting June 1. Each age group has their own: birth to 5 years of age, 6 to 11 years of age and 12 to 17 years of age.

Club Read is a celebration of reading for children who read at all levels, even pre-readers who are still being read to. It's an opportunity for kids to join friends and neighbors in a common activity, to read books of their own choosing instead of what they must read for school, to feel the sense of accomplishment that comes from completing a goal and to experience the fun of earning a prize in acknowledgement of their efforts.

In addition to reading fun, special programs are planned for kids of all ages. Laurie Berkner, an award-winning children's recording artist and preschool television favorite, will be live in concert. Steve Weeks will entertain with music, humor and games. The Hampstead Stage Company will perform *Robin Hood* and the fabulous Fratello Marionettes will perform a variety show presented in the spirit of the old-time music hall. And the Award Goes To...

Don't let the kids have all the fun this summer! Why not do some summer reading of your own? The Library's extensive catalog includes titles that have won some very impressive awards. Here are a few books and authors that won in 2014 and you can find them at your library.

The **Nobel Prize for Literature** has been awarded to writers for their achievements in literature since 1901. The winner for 2014 was Patrick Modiano, "for the art of memory with which he has evoked the most ungraspable human destinies and uncovered the life-world of the occupation." Modiano is a best-selling novelist and the winner of some of the most prestigious literary awards in France, including the Prix Goncourt and the Prix Mondial Cino Del Duca for lifetime achievement. The city of Paris plays a central role in his writing, and we have many of his works in our collection, including *Suspended Sentences*, *Dora Bruder* and *Missing Person*.


The **Pulitzer Prize for Fiction** is awarded for distinguished fiction by an American author, preferably dealing with American life. In 2014, the prize was awarded to Donna Tartt's *The Goldfinch*, a beautifully written coming-of-age novel with exquisitely drawn characters that follows a grieving boy's entanglement with a small famous painting that has eluded destruction, a book that stimulates the mind and touches the heart.

The **Pulitzer Prize for Nonfiction** is awarded for a distinguished and appropriately documented book of nonfiction by an American author. Dan Fagin's *Toms River: A Story of Science and Salvation*, a book that deftly combines investigative reporting and historical research to probe a New Jersey seashore town's cluster of childhood cancers linked to water and air pollution received the prize in 2014.

Richard Flanagan's *The Narrow Road to the Deep North* won the **Man Booker Prize** in 2014, the United Kingdom's top literary prize. Flanagan is the author of several novels including *The Sound of One Hand Clapping*, *Gould's Book of Fish*, *The Unknown Terrorist* and *Wanting*, which have received numerous honors and have been published in 26 countries.

The **Edgar® Award**, named after Edgar Allen Poe, is presented by the Mystery Writers of America, dedicated to promoting a higher regard for crime writing. William Kent Krueger's *Ordinary Grace*, a novel about a young man, a small town and murder in the summer of 1961 won for Best Novel in 2014.

Las Vegas Stories: The Mob's Hidden Hand in Las Vegas Clark County Library Thursday, June 4 at 7 p.m.

Many of America's most notorious organized crime figures played pivotal roles in the rise of Las Vegas. From Meyer Lansky and Moe Dalitz to Bugsy Siegel, the mob was a behind-the-scenes force in the Las Vegas casino industry from the 1940s to the 1970s. Mob Museum's Director of Content Geoff Schumacher will explain how it all happened and why it ended. Schumacher is the author of *Howard Hughes: Power, Paranoia & Palace Intrigue*, published in 2008, and *Sun, Sin & Suburbia: The History of Modern Las Vegas*, published in 2012. He was also the editor of *Nevada: 150 Years in the Silver State*, the official book commemorating Nevada's sesquicentennial in 2014.






