Kids who sign up get a reading log to track the books they read, and a special Club Read membership card and a card wallet to put it in!

Club Read is a celebration of reading for children who read at all levels, even pre-readers who are still being read to. It's an opportunity for kids to join friends and neighbors in a common activity, to read books of their own choosing instead of what they must read for school, to feel the sense of accomplishment that comes from completing a goal, and to experience the fun of earning a prize in acknowledgement of their efforts.

In addition to reading fun, special programs are planned for kids of all ages. Norman Foote will entertain with funny songs, puppets and props. DJ Tony will get kids moving to the beat and the fabulous Fratello Marionettes will perform "Carnival of the Animals" featuring *The Three Little Pigs*, *The Tortoise and the Hare* and *The Ugly Duckling*. Club Read is a free program that offers teens, toddlers and school-age children and their families the opportunity to have fun while keeping track of their reading.

It's easy to participate, it's fun and it's free!

Reading logs may be picked up at the Library starting June 1. Children from birth to 11 years of age have one log, and teens in grades six and up have a different log just for them. Reading may also be tracked online, through the Library's website at www.lvccld.org.

Every child who signs up for Club Read will get a membership card and a special wallet to put it in!



All participants earn a Book Buck for every five books that are read aloud to them, or they read on their own. They can exchange the Book Buck at any Library District Foundation Used Bookstore for one item of their choice. After they read 20 books, they'll earn a special prize and an entry into a drawing for a chance to win a \$50 Target gift card!

Book Bucks are available until August 2, and only while supplies last, and may be redeemed through August 16, 2014.





Out West with Buffalo Bill

The words "heterosexual" and "homosexual" did not surface in the cultural vernacular until the early 1900s. William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody was as "unprejudiced as a man could be" according to prominent western historians. Was Buffalo Bill "gay" friendly before the word existed? Based on Gregory Hinton's scholarship as a 2011 Buffalo Bill Historical Center's Resident Fellow, this program examines Cody's cordial acquaintanceships with flamboyant Irish poet, lecturer and playwright Oscar Wilde and acclaimed 19th century French painter Rosa Bonheur, who carried a government permit to dress like a man.


Nevada's Story: A Sesquicentennial Celebration




