**The Northwest Area Command (NWAC) Crime Prevention Office provides the following information to assist you:**

- **NWAC Crime Prevention Specialist** Kathy Perkins can be reached at 828-4305 or via email at [k2482p@lvmpd.com](mailto:k2482p@lvmpd.com). Most messages or emails are returned promptly but delays can occur.
- **Neighborhood Watch.** A voluntary program uniting neighbors and NWAC in an effort to enhance neighborhood safety. Initial meetings are held in the neighborhood. Call Crime Prevention for specifics.
- **"First Tuesday" Community Awareness Meeting.** This is a community program presented on the first Tuesday of most months at 7 PM at NWAC. It includes a police related topic of interest, Q & A, and, an opportunity to meet area police officers. "First Tuesday" is not held on election Tuesday's or in the month of August. "National Night Out" is celebrated in August in area neighborhoods.
- **Free home and business safety/security reviews.** Done at your home or business and usually takes less than one hour depending upon circumstances. A popular service to help identify crime prevention options.
- **Limited meeting presentations** for your group on crime prevention and safety. Call to discuss topic options. Not all requests can be honored due to scheduling availability.
- **Varied crime prevention literature** is available in the front lobby of NWAC. Additional topics may be available for other crime risks / prevention information. **Ask to be included in our email list!**
