

Paradise-Whitney Interceptor



The Paradise-Whitney Interceptor (PWI) is a multi-year project to ensure our community maintains a safe and reliable infrastructure for delivering wastewater from our homes and businesses to the treatment facilities.

The PWI project consists of 13 miles of large diameter pipeline (48" to 72" diameter) constructed from Valley View Boulevard and Serene Avenue in the southwest valley to Nellis Boulevard and Flamingo Road in the southeast valley. Portions of the collection system (the network of pipes and pumps to deliver the wastewater) are at, and even above capacity. The project will ensure adequate capacity and a more reliable system

into the future. The project will begin construction in mid to late 2014.

The project will be constructed in three packages:

Central segment includes 4 miles of 54-inch diameter pipe within McLeod Drive, Sunset Road, Eastern Avenue, Warm Springs Road, Tamarus Street and Eldorado Lane. This segment will also include installation of one mile of 12 and 15-inch diameter pipe within Eastern Avenue, and Big Top Drive.

Eastern segment includes 5 miles of 54, 60, 66, and 72-inch diameter pipe within Nellis Boulevard, Hacienda Avenue, Lamb Boulevard, Oquendo Road, Pearl Street and Patrick Lane. It also includes installation of the sewer within the Grapevine Springs Park boundary.

Western segment includes 4 miles of 48 and 54-inch diameter pipe within Eldorado Lane, Bermuda Road, Wigwam Avenue and Valley View Boulevard. It also includes approximately 1 mile of 15-inch diameter pipe within Las Vegas Boulevard and Ford Avenue.



There will be periodic activity during the design phase, and neighbors may see engineers and surveyors performing work on their street in advance of the construction activities. Traffic impacts during the duration of this project will vary.
