May 10, 2014—Last day to register to vote or update your existing registration without having to appear in person or registering through the Secretary of State's Internet site.

May 11—20, 2014 - In-Office or through Secretary of State internet site registration only.

May 24 - June 6, 2014 - Early voting within the County.

June 3, 2014—Mail/Absentee Ballot request deadline.

June 10, 2014—Primary Election Day

October 18—31, 2014 - Early voting within County.

November 4, 2014 - General Election Day!
