



NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

I-215, Airport Connector Phase 2

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on I-215 and the Airport Connector corridor. Starting Sunday night, November 1, 2015, and continuing through the morning of Friday, November 6, 2015, the following I-215 on and off ramps will be closed and traffic will be detoured from 9:00 pm to 5:00 am:

- Southbound Airport Connector loop ramp to eastbound I-215
- The eastbound I-215 off-ramp (Exit 10) to northbound Airport Connector

These closures are necessary to complete the placement of falsework for the widening of an existing bridge structure.

Please use Russell Road or Tropicana Avenue as alternate routes. Travel from the airport to westbound I-215 will still be accessible with current lane restrictions.
