



NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

I-215, Airport Connector Phase 2

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on I-215 and the Airport Connector corridor. The project consists of a direct connect flyover bridge structure from southbound Airport Connector to eastbound I-215, widening of I-215 for auxiliary and ramp lanes and the realignment of the eastbound I-215 off-ramp to Warm Springs Road.

The project has been awarded to Las Vegas Paving Corp. Construction is anticipated to start on Monday, August 3, 2015, with work underway for approximately two years. Normal construction hours will be Monday through Friday, 6:00AM to 3:30PM. Night work and weekend work will occur on a limited basis. Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Some lanes will be restricted, reduced or closed at various times for the duration of the project.
- Message boards will be placed to provide a two-week notice for traffic control changes.
- Local traffic is encouraged to use alternate routes whenever possible.
