



Admission Guidelines

Admission into the New Genesis Compass House program is assessed on a qualitative, rather than quantitative, basis. Instead of providing a check list of criteria, such as employment and health status, we are looking for applicants who possess a **combination of attitudes and attributes that are conducive to eventual independence:**

- 1) Does the client display an appetite for independent living?
- 2) Is there a reasonable expectation that, with aggressive assistance, the client could maintain employment?
- 3) Is the client reasonably receptive to the notion of a sober living environment?
- 4) Can the client function at a level that would allow him/her to live in a communal environment, in his/her own room?

Beyond these indicators, admission is limited to:

- 1) Individuals without children, or whose children are currently not in their custody
- 2) Persons without a criminal history of sexual offenses

Our greatest goal with regard to admissions is to cultivate an understanding with our referring agencies, so they understand our program and have a general notion of who will succeed therein.
