is a participant in the Clark County Social Service Step Up Program. The purpose of the Step Up Program, contracted by the Department of Family Services, is to assist current and former foster youth in their transition to adulthood. With the following conditions, he/she is currently eligible to receive monthly rental assistance in an amount up to \$800.00.

He/She must be gainfully employed, working at least 20 hours and/or  
He/She must be enrolled in GED/High school or college classes showing a minimum of 9 credit hours and/or a combination of both.

To give you a brief background about our program, Step Up was designed to provide limited financial assistance to young adults that were served by the *foster care* system in Clark County. Former foster care youth between the ages of 18 to 21 have access to these limited funds for the purpose of but not limited to: secured housing, employment & educational training, medical needs, transportation expenses, and additional emergencies that arise in transitional periods. The limited funds provided are also used as incentives for youth to encourage and support the educational component in their lives.
