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Child Haven Visitor Privacy and Confidentiality Agreement

This Visitor Privacy and Confidentiality Agreement (the "Agreement") is made between Clark County Family Services and _____ ("Visitor,") a visitor entering the Child Haven facility.

Confidentiality: Visitor acknowledges that while visiting Child Haven, Visitor may receive information maintained by an agency which provides child welfare services pursuant to NRS 432B. This information may include, but is not limited to, meeting with or seeing children at the Child Haven facility, learning information about the children such as their names and information about their lives or families, and learning information regarding cases managed by Clark County Family Services. Visitor agrees that any information observed or obtained while visiting Child Haven is sensitive and confidential. Maintaining confidentiality of this information is vital to protecting both the safety of the children and the privacy of the families served by Clark County Family Services.

Visitor agrees:

- To preserve in strict confidence any information obtained or observed while visiting Child Haven. This includes the identities of children and families being served by Clark County Family Services, including their names, gender, ages, reason for coming into care, etc.
- Visitor's confidentiality obligation is on-going and does not end when the visit to Child Haven ends.
- Not to take any photographs or videos while at Child Haven, unless otherwise specifically authorized by Clark County Family Services.
- Failure to maintain confidentiality, and to abide by this Agreement, may result in Visitor being immediately escorted from Child Haven.
- Visitor understands that both federal and state statutes protect the confidentiality of the information Visitor may observe and obtain while at Child Haven. **Visitor further understands that some of these statutes, as outlined in NRS 432B.280, provide possible civil and criminal penalties for the unauthorized disclosure of confidential information. Criminal penalties as described by NRS 193.140 include, but are not limited to, fines of up to \$2,000 and/or up to three-hundred and sixty-four (364) days in jail.**
