The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Please see the attached for all project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

This project provides support toward the evaluation of covered species status for future consultation of Clark County with the US Fish and Wildlife Service and other agencies toward the amendment of the Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP) and ultimately the renewal of their permit allowing further growth.

The major accomplishment or findings of this project include:

- Produced new species accounts for 38 species that had no previous account
- Completed updates on 18 species with species accounts that were prepared in earlier efforts of the MSHCP
- Developed species habitat models for 31 species without prior models
- Reviewed species habitat models for all 25 species that had models previously developed.
