

DATA NOTICE

The County, pursuant to NRS 239.010, maintains databases of public books and records which are open to inspection and duplication by the public; and the company or individual noticed herein provides information and services to the public or for internal use which utilizes data from public records; and the company or individual is desirous of accessing directly the County's data base for the purpose of acquiring the information contained in public record for the use of its customers, subscribers, employees and/or shareholders.

Please note the following:

1. County shall provide access to public information through electronic terminal access, FTP file transfer or by other electronic media only in a manner that protects the security and integrity of the County databases and networks.
2. The company or individual shall within 30 days of written notification by County reimburse County for all expenses necessarily incurred in providing the data requested, said amount to include but not to be limited to the cost of preparation, delivery and review of requested data. Failure to provide reimbursement may result in revocation of any ongoing electronic access.
3. In the event any confidential data is inadvertently revealed to the company or individual in connection with furnishing of the records herein specified, the company or individual shall not reveal the same to any person nor utilize said information in any manner. The company or individual shall either destroy or return to County said confidential data if notified by the County.
4. The County makes no warranties as to the accuracy, or validity of the information provided, assumes no liability for errors, omissions or inaccuracies that may occur in said information, and accepts no responsibility for the correctness of any records subsequently produced by the company or individual with the use of said data.
5. The County is not responsible for any liability, damage, claims, suits, liens and judgments of whatever nature, including but not limited to, claims for contribution and/or indemnification for injuries to any person or persons caused by the company or individual's dissemination of this data. The County may seek compensation at its rate of cost, for any extraordinary expenses incurred by County as a result of the company or individual's dissemination of data attributed to County which the company or individual knows to be inaccurate.
6. The County may terminate any continuing information services for its convenience at any time with or without prior notice.
