How Drivers Can Make School Zones Safer

REDUCE YOUR SPEED

Be aware of upcoming school zones and reduce your speed. In most, the speed limit through a school zone is between 15 and 25 mph. Reduce your speed through the school zone.

LOOK FOR INCREASED TRAFFIC

Traffic can become congested during drop-off and pick-up times, so plan accordingly. You may need to get up a little earlier and leave work a few minutes later to avoid the congestion.



KNOW THE BUS RULES

When the **red lights** are on and the **stop sign** is extended from the side, you **cannot pass** the bus.



DOUBLE PARKING AND U-TURNS ARE NOT ALLOWED

LOOK FOR PEDESTRIANS

Be on the lookout for kids darting into traffic or dodging cars to get across the street. Not all children will use a crosswalk. Don't tailgate, and be prepared to stop.
