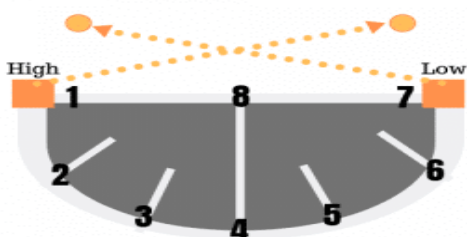

What is Skeet Shooting?

Skeet is one of the three major disciplines of clay target shooting in the United States which includes trap shooting and sporting clays.

In all three disciplines, the same clay target is used. All are 4 5/16" in diameter and 1 1/8" high. They're launched from a variety of clay target machines which spin the target to provide stability in flight.

Depending on the discipline, the targets are thrown to provide a variety of distances and challenging angles.

For the purposes of this class, we'll be concentrating on American Skeet, with a target flight of 60 yards and repetitive flight path. It's the shooter's position which varies greatly on a skeet field, resulting in target presentations that range from easy to quite difficult. During this training, your instructor will take you step-by-step through a 25-target round of American Skeet.

Your goal should be to have fun and enjoy the camaraderie shared on a skeet field, while learning to be safe moving about the field. You're not encumbered by voice-release target systems found on trap fields, nor the rigors of moving great distances on a sporting clays course. You will leave prepared to come back and enjoy this lifetime sport on your own or to share with your family and friends!

Instructors

Your **Sunday Morning Greet & Skeet**

instructors are badged volunteers of the Shooting Complex. Each of them will share their techniques as they accompany you around the skeet field, leading the way, up close and personal. Their emphasis for students- Be safe, enjoy the experience, and receive the skills & confidence to return and shoot with us again!

Equipment

We provide everything you need. The firearms are specialized for skeet in both 20 and 12-gauge, standard & compact models. We can fit anyone to ensure they have an enjoyable outing. Note- You may bring your own modern firearm if equipped with traditional buttstock and fitted with barrels at least 24" in length. Personal firearm use requires approval of the instructor. Personal ammunition will not be used.

Fees

The fee for the class is \$45/student. This includes the instructor, use of firearm, one box of ammunition and 25 clay targets. If time permits, your instructor may offer additional shooting for cost of ammunition and clays only. Ear & eye protection is required and available for purchase. Personal Rx/Sunglasses acceptable.

Skeet Shooting:
