

NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Sloan Lane Improvements - Vegas Valley Drive to Ruby Creek Drive

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Sloan Lane.

The primary project location is on Sloan Lane from Vegas Valley Drive to Ruby Creek Drive with additional work occurring at the intersection of Sahara Avenue and Sloan Lane. This project will extend Sloan Lane with a paved road and bridge going over the Las Vegas Wash to connect Ruby Creek Drive to Vegas Valley Drive. The work will consist of improvements including asphalt pavement, median, sidewalk, curb and gutter, channel, storm drain, streetlights, traffic signal, landscaping, utility adjustments pavement marking, and signage.

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Some lanes will be restricted, reduced, or closed at various times for the duration of the project.
- Message boards will be placed in advance to provide a two-week notice for traffic control changes.
- Local traffic is encouraged to use alternate routes whenever possible.
- Additional notices will be distributed to your specific address 72 hours prior to construction activity impacts near residents or business.
- The contractor will ensure that driveway access within traffic control setups will be maintained. The contractor will coordinate with properties whose driveways will be directly affected.
