MPC-25-0332-MOAPA NORTH VILLAGE, LLC:
CONCEPT SPECIFIC PLAN for a mixed-use comprehensive planned community and the identification of related issues of concern to Clark County, affected property owners, and the applicant on 2,046.9 acres in an RS80 (Residential Single-Family 80) Zone, an RS40 (Residential Single-Family 40) Zone, an RS5.2 (Residential Single-Family 5.2) Zone, a CG (Commercial General) Zone, an H-2 (General Highway Frontage) Zone, an IL (Industrial Light) Zone, an IH (Industrial Heavy) Zone, and a PF (Public Facilities) Zone. Generally located north of Interstate 15 and east and west of State Highway 168 within Moapa. MK/hw/cv (For possible action)

Devin Perry and David Brown spoke on behalf of applicants. Hunter White spoke on behalf of Clark County. They answered many of the same questions as before. Who pays for the infrastructure? The density is too high; you will bring in 10 times the current population. Flooding and Streets cannot sustain this kind of growth. Mr. Brown offered to come out and lay out the whole process, so that people can understand what happens and when it happens. We received numerous letters of concern, (see attached) and they were submitted for the record. People were concerned regarding light pollution, schools, drainage, traffic, Fire Dept., Police officers.

Parks

- 1. Exercise Stations and Benches along existing walking paths.
- 2. Sand Volleyball behind or side of Library, and horseshoes. (Local <u>business</u> may supply the sand)
- 3. Shade similar to the existing one in small children's playground area and Splash Pad.
- 4. Outdoor basketball 1/2 court
- 5. Add on to gym, or portable classrooms or bungalows classes.
- 6. Indoor Swimming Pool.

Public Works

- 1.Repave and Reengineer SIM. NOTE: This road is the only other option when flooding occurs.
- 2. Extend barrier rails to the Warm Springs Loop.
- 3. Maintain Dude Rd. (Off Hwy 168 Glendale area.)
- 4.Additional <u>lights @</u> Rox & Fire Station for turning into facilities/expansion of Rox for turn lane for emergency personnel. Need additional parking from Fire Station to Rox (currently dirt lot)
- 5. Maintain Barlow from Lawson to Rox Rd
