SAMPLE BALLOTS:

All "[active](#)" registered voters who registered in-person or online on or before May 16, 2026, will be sent a sample ballot. Voters who registered on or after May 17, 2026, will not automatically be sent a sample ballot for the current election.

ALL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION:

All "[active](#)" voters who registered on or before May 26, 2026, will receive a mail ballot. However, those who submitted a "[Mail Ballot Preference Form](#)" by April 10, 2026, to opt-out of mail ballot voting will not be sent a mail ballot.

MAIL BALLOT DROP-OFF LOCATIONS: 182

NOTE: All [early voting sites](#) and [Election Day vote centers](#) will be mail ballot drop-off locations during their scheduled dates and hours of operation. [City Clerks' offices and the Clark County Election Department](#) will also be available for mail ballot drop off from May 16 to June 9, 2026 (dates and times vary, some locations will be closed on specific days).

EARLY VOTING SITES:

Long-Term Sites (open at the same location for longer time periods): **23**

Short-Term Neighborhood Sites (open only on specific dates): **69**

TOTAL: **92**

NOTE: Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at any Clark County early voting site you choose no matter where you live or what your precinct is in Clark County. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have your mail ballot with you and you had received it, you must sign an affirmation that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, [same-day registration and updates](#) of existing registration are available at all early voting sites.

ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTERS: 137

NOTE: Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at any Vote Center you choose from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, no matter where you live or what your precinct is in Clark County. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have your mail ballot with you and you had received it, you must sign an affirmation that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, [same-day registration and updates](#) of existing registration are available at all Election Day vote centers.
