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Items to discuss

Art Committee Bylaws state

- The Committee consists of seven (7) members which shall include two (2) arts faculty members from accredited institutions of higher education in Clark County, one (1) professional architect or landscape architect, one (1) arts staff member from a local entity within Southern Nevada, excluding Clark County. The remainder of positions shall be filled by independent professional artists if such individuals are available to serve. Members shall be chosen by the Department of Parks and Recreation and the selections ratified by the BCC.
- Should a Committee member no longer reside in Clark County, resign, term expire or otherwise vacate the Committee position, his or her membership shall automatically expire. The replacement member will represent that same group/party the former member represented if possible.

An amendment describing whether a member remains eligible to continue serving following a loss of qualifications including a reference to how many months eligible.

- Under NRS 287.325, committee members who cease to have the necessary qualifications are allowed to continue to serve so long as their remaining term does not exceed 24 months.
- NRS 287.041 requires that a member who ceases to have the necessary qualifications will immediately lose their position unless the member is in the final 12 months of their term.
- NRS 391.455 states that the loss of a qualification constitutes an immediate vacancy and it is necessary to appoint a replacement for the remainder of the term.

Each member may serve two consecutive terms, and then must step off the board for at least one term.

From Parade to the Strip:
The Origins of Aku Aku
When Aku Aku opened in January 1960 at the Stardust Resort and Casino, it introduced a vivid burst of tropical imagination to the Las Vegas Strip. Arriving at the height of America's fascination with Tiki-themed entertainment, the restaurant invited visitors to leave the Mojave Desert behind and step into an immersive island fantasy shaped by mid-century design, creative lighting, and theatrical showmanship. Guests first encountered towering moai figures like the one you see here. After crossing a small bridge beneath their steady gaze, diners entered a setting filled with bamboo ceilings, flickering torches, glowing water features, carved wooden details, and murals inspired by distant seas. Colorful cocktails in souvenir mugs and themed menu items reinforced the sense of embarking on an exotic journey without ever leaving the Strip. The restaurant was named for Thor Heyerdahl's bestselling book *Aku Aku: The Secret of Easter Island*, and its designers borrowed imagery from the ancestral moai of Rapa Nui. This sculpture is an American interpretation rather than an original carving, yet it reflects the imagination, spectacle, and creativity that shaped mid-century Las Vegas. Although Aku Aku closed around 1980, its legacy endures in the city's Tiki heritage and in this remarkable sculpture, now a beloved landmark of Sunset Park.

A Giant Gaze:
The Moai at Sunset Park
The colossal stone figure before you once stood along the glittering Las Vegas Strip, greeting visitors to the Polynesian-themed Aku Aku restaurant at the former Stardust Resort and Casino. Carved in 1959 from volcanic stone, this moai-style sculpture originally welcomed guests as they crossed the restaurant's entrance bridge. Rising nearly 30 feet tall, its stoic expression and commanding presence drew visitors into a world of fantasy, escapism, and the excitement of mid-century Las Vegas.
