RE: Transient Tax Reporting

Dear Transient Tax Licensee,

<u>Please review this notice regarding the reporting of rental revenue and remitting transient lodging taxes carefully.</u>

An Accommodation Facilitator business license only allows for the reporting of rental revenue and remitting transient lodging taxes on behalf of a licensed Short-Term Rental Unit. Therefore, if you are <u>not</u> a licensed Short-term Rental Unit owner, <u>you</u> are responsible for remitting transient tax each month, regardless if your rental was booked through a licensed Accommodation Facilitator. Please note: Clark County does not have a Voluntary Collection Agreement with any Accommodation Facilitator.

Per Clark County Code 7.100.020(a), an accommodations facilitator "means a person, other than the owner, lessee or other lawful occupant of a residential unit, or a manager of a residential unit, who, for a fee or other charge, brokers, coordinates, makes available or otherwise arranges for the **rental of a short-term rental unit**. The term includes, without limitation, a hosting platform."

Per Clark County Code 7.100.020(q) "Short-term rental license" means a license issued by the Clark County Department of Business License to an eligible property owner who, independently or using an accommodations facilitator, makes available for rent a short-term rental unit

Per Clark County Code 7.100.020(r) "Short-term rental unit" means a residential unit or room within a residential unit that is made available for rent for thirty consecutive days or less.
