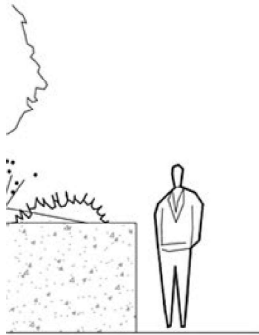

HOLLYWOOD BASEBALL PARK SCULPTURE

 - Front of baseball park at parent drop-off
 - GROUND AREA: 30' X 20' HEIGHT OF ADJACENT WALL: 4'
- BUDGET: \$100,000
- THEME: Baseball
- KEY POINTS:
 - Back of the round area is a slope.
 - Front is a 4' drop, may need guardrails.
 - Build ending in September of 2027

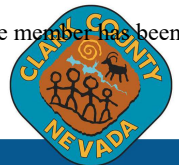

AMENDMENT:

Section III of the Clark County Public Art Advisory Committee Bylaws currently reads:

SECTION III: MEMBERSHIP

- The Committee consists of seven (7) members which shall include two (2) arts faculty members from accredited institutions of higher education in Clark County, one (1) professional architect or landscape architect, one (1) arts staff member from a local entity within Southern Nevada, excluding Clark County. The remainder of positions shall be filled by independent professional artists if such individuals are available to serve. Members shall be chosen by the Department of Parks and Recreation and the selections ratified by the BCC.
- The term of each member shall commence at the next Committee meeting following that member's ratification by the Board and shall expire three years thereafter. Each member may serve two consecutive terms, and then must step off the board for at least one term.
- Should a Committee member no longer reside in Clark County, resign, term expire or otherwise vacate the Committee position, his or her membership shall automatically expire. The replacement member will represent that same group/party the former member represented if possible.
- Any Committee member who compiles more than three consecutive unexcused absences or attends less than fifty percent of the regularly scheduled meetings within a calendar year, shall be considered to have resigned.
- Excused absences are defined as absences due to illness of a member or a member's family, employment-related activities, or other instances as approved by the Chair on a case-by-case basis. Notifications of absences are to be made to the ex-officio secretary of the Committee.
- Any Committee member may be removed from office for cause by a majority vote of the Committee, after such Committee member has been advised of the reason(s) behind the vote and afforded an opportunity to be fairly heard by the Committee.

Amendment(s) to Section III of the Clark County Public Art Advisory Committee Bylaws are as proposed:

SECTION III: MEMBERSHIP

- The Committee consists of seven (7) members which shall include:
 - two (2) arts faculty members from accredited institutions of higher education in Clark County,
 - one (1) professional architect or landscape architect,
 - one (1) arts staff member from a local entity within Southern Nevada, ~~excluding Clark County.~~
 - The remainder of positions shall be filled by independent professional artists if such individuals are available to serve.
 - Members shall be chosen by the Department of Parks and Recreation and the selections ratified by the BCC.
- The term of each member shall commence at the next Committee meeting following that member's ratification by the Board and shall expire three years thereafter. Each member may serve two consecutive terms, and then must step off the board for at least one term.
- Should a member of the Committee qualified to serve as a representative of a group, as described in Section III (A)(1), (2), or (3), cease to have the necessary qualification to serve as a representative member of that group, they shall be allowed to continue to serve as a member of the committee so long as their remaining term does not exceed 24 months.
- Should a member of the Committee qualified to serve as a representative of a group, as described in Section III(A)(1), (2), or (3), vacate their Committee position, another present member of the Committee possessing a qualification to serve as a representative of the group which the former Committee member represented, who is not already representing another group as described in Section III(A)(1), (2) or (3), may immediately begin to represent that group for the remainder of the present member's current term.
- Should a Committee member no longer reside in Clark County, resign, term expire or otherwise vacate the Committee position, his or her membership shall automatically expire. If a vacating Committee member represents a group as described in Section III(A)(1), (2), or (3), and no other present member of the Committee is eligible to act as a group representative pursuant to Section III(D), the replacement member will represent the same group the former member represented if possible.
- Any Committee member who compiles more than three consecutive unexcused absences or attends less than fifty percent of the regularly scheduled meetings within a calendar year, shall be considered to have resigned.
- Excused absences are defined as absences due to illness of a member or a member's family, employment-related activities, or other instances as approved by the Chair on a case-by-case basis. Notifications of absences are to be made to the ex-officio secretary of the Committee.
- Any Committee member may be removed from office for cause by a majority vote of the Committee, after such Committee member has been advised of the reason(s) behind the vote and afforded an opportunity to be fairly heard by the Committee.



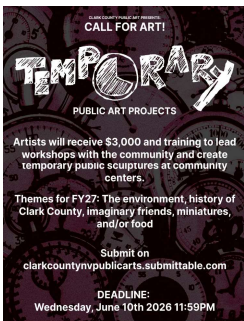
