Welcome

All Nevada Youth Trapshooting Teams!

The Clark County Shooting Complex is ground zero for this youth trapshooting league, but all students in Nevada are invited and encouraged to participate! Those outside of Clark County may partner up with friends from a neighboring county or club to make up their team.

It's recommended each team have a minimum of 4 shooters but having 5 is preferred. This allows the team to drop their low score each week and score their top 4. Post the best possible score as you're competing against the entire field of other Varsity or Junior Varsity teams. The only requirement is that all students range from grades 6 - 12, and all team scores from outside Clark County are submitted during the 7-day period between 8am Sunday and 5pm Saturday each week of scheduled trapshooting league activity.

Fees

A one-time \$18 Student Athlete Fee will be required from each participant at the Clark County Shooting Complex. This fee will cover the first two weeks of league clays used and contribute 20% of the participants trophy fee. Only additional costs incurred by student athletes would be for weekly ammunition and practice targets. We anticipate local sponsors will cover remaining league target and trophy costs.

League Format

One scorekeeper and a minimum of one coach or safety officer will be present on the field when student athletes are participating in league competition.

Up to 5 team-mates shoot 25 clay targets each from the 16-yard line on eight designated Thursday afternoons between 3-6pm at the Shooting Complex.

All team members must shoot together.

No early or late make-up by missing team members!

Outside of Clark County, team members will have until 5pm each Saturday to shoot and submit their scores. They may shoot at two different clubs, at different times, and on different days.

The top 4 scores from each team will be used to earn weekly team points!

Special Rules

Teams are welcome to add a 6th member, an alternate, to their roster, but a maximum of only 5 will compete on a weekly basis.

All team rosters and team alternates are considered final following the third week of competition.

Anyone listed as an alternate can compete with only one team but may shoot any week of the league.

In the event a team member is unable to attend a week of competition, the team may elect to use the absent team members average, -2, based on his/her previous two weeks of scores to assist their team in earning weekly points. Using an absent shooters average -2 is referred to as a "blind" score and allowed only one time per team member during the league. Teams also have the option of using a substitute if available. A substitute may shoot for any team with exception of week 7 or 8.

Varsity Teams - Grades 10, 11 & 12. Varsity teams may recruit from lower grade levels.

Junior Varsity Teams - Grades 6, 7, 8 & 9. Junior Varsity **may not** recruit from higher grade levels.

Should any scheduled league competition be canceled at any location, for any reason, a make-up round will be required the following week. This will require two rounds be entered the same day. Should adverse conditions prevail during the make-up period, we'll revert to the option below:

Should a scheduled league competition be canceled in weeks 1, 2, 3, or 4, actual scores and points from week 5 will be applied to the canceled week.

Should a scheduled league competition be canceled in weeks 5, 6, 7, or 8, actual scores and points from week 2 will be applied to the canceled week.

Note - due to different geographical locations of the ASTL, conditions at one location may allow competition to proceed but may prohibit competition at others. Any scores that are shot prior to, or on the scheduled day of competition will be used and applied to the official records.

Why did the ASTL Move to Thursday Afternoons?

A Special Message from Terry Barkey, ASTL Committee Member and President of the Silver State Clay Breakers.

This 501(c)(3) organization has been teaching our local youth the clay target sports since being founded in 2012. Our group practices once a week on Thursday evenings at the Clark County Shooting Complex starting at 6:00 PM.

Our shoot year begins in late August with our last practice session held during the middle part of June. This coincides with the Clark County ASTL, potentially allowing more student athletes to participate in both programs.

The coaching staff are: 1. NRA Certified 2. Have had background checks 3. Have taken the "Double Goal Coaching" course that emphasizes good, ethical coaching skills. The well-being of each athlete is taken into consideration and teaching the clay shooting disciplines is highlighted at each practice. Emphasis on gun safety, proper shooting etiquette, overall sportsmanship, and excellent team building skills are among the most important aspects of our coaching staff and program.

The initial cost to join the Clay Breakers Shooting Team is \$175.00 per shooter and \$75.00 each year after. Initial cost includes: • Gun Safety Orientation for each shooter • One-on-one instruction with a certified coach • Gun fitting, discussion of what is needed to shoot • Loaner guns if needed (provided by both Clay Breakers and through the Clark County Shooting Complex) (loaner guns are provided until the athlete acquires his own and are NOT taken home by the student athlete) • Each shooter will be provided with a Team shirt, hat and vest • The cost to shoot the monthly NSTA Big 50 and the 1st Sunday Social 16-yard events, plus the Nevada State Championships in October are covered by the annual dues.. The Silver State Clay Breakers organization teaches our young shooters not only the overall skills necessary to be proficient and competitive shooters but also to assist them in gaining the necessary self-confidence in themselves that can carry over into their daily lives.
